Good morning Allies,

Welcome to the Rally Blast for today, Saturday, May 24th.

While today isn't a rally day, below are the highlights of what's coming up shortly.

# **Sunday Arrivals**

Many of you will be arriving at the fairgrounds tomorrow, Sunday, May 25. Our parking team will be ready for you starting at **8:00am** and will continue to be at the entrance

until **5:00pm**. If you arrive before or after those hours, there will be a sign with a phone number to call. Check-in will happen at Gate 7. This is to help with all the traffic that will build up during busy arrival times. Please use <u>this link</u> to see a map that shows where Gate 7 is located.

### **Golf Cart Rentals**

If you have reserved a golf cart with a <u>Sunday, May 25 pick-up date</u>, our parking team will communicate your arrival and site number with our golf cart team so they can deliver it. If you are picking your golf cart up ANY other day outside of Sunday, please plan to go to the Dairy Barn (down the street from where the service desk is located) between 9am and 10am to pick up your cart. The "Check-Out" date for your golf cart is the day your cart must be turned in by 10am to avoid any additional charges. Carts need to be returned to the Dairy Barn by 10am on the Check-Out date.

Feel free to email rally@alliancerv.com if you are not sure when your reservation starts and ends. If you rented your golf cart until Saturday, May 31, we are asking that you return it Friday night at dinner. We will give more directions in Friday's email blast. We will have parking team available to give rides back to your campsite.
