Pump Out Service

There will be pump out trucks coming through the fairgrounds this morning. If you need a pump out today, your pump out medallion **MUST** be visibly located on your hitch before 8:00am. While the online pump out purchase form is now closed, you can purchase pump outs at the Alliance merchandise table in the Vendor Hall (building A). For pump outs on Thursday or Friday, we strongly advise putting your medallion out the night before to ensure your unit is not missed the next morning.
